It was sobering to hear that this was just one of thousands of situations in countries like Uganda where a little legal help in Christ's love could make a big difference!

As the conference came to a close we were struck with the humility and devotion of these men and women to represent Christ wherever they were. *I also sold some of my books. One lawyer (I think) asked me to autograph my book, which he was giving to his son who is a budding musician and worship leader! It is certainly humbling to think that God could use words I've written to reach others I don't know. I pray that He does use it to equip this young man and others for His glory!*
